BILLS TABLED

HB 361 Hibbard 4/6/93 General revision of benefits and medical definitions under workers' compensation laws.

BILLS ACTED UPON

BE CONCURRED IN

HB 511 Hibbard 4/5/93
(Bartlett) An act creating a workers' compensation database system on which to compile management information.

HB 587 Harper 4/5/93
(Towe) An act revising workers' compensation CRC provisions.

BE CONCURRED IN AS AMENDED

HB 453 Molnar 4/5/93
(Forrester) An act creating a civil fine for workers' compensation fraud, creating a reward system for people supplying information leading to conviction of workers' compensation fraud, and providing that money collected from persons convicted of workers' compensation fraud be put toward workers' compensation fraud investigation.

HB 13 Benedict 4/6/93
(Harp) Generally revising workers' compensation law and revising State Fund's budget/financing procedure.

HB 622 Ewer 4/6/93
(Towe) An act generally revising workers' compensation and occupational disease laws.

HB 504 Benedict 4/6/93
(Harp) An act increasing employer and employee payroll tax to pay off workers' compensation old fund liability.

HJR 33 Grimes 4/22/93
(Keating) A joint resolution requesting an interim study of 24-hour health care coverage as an alternative to the present workers' compensation system in Montana.
